Pro Football Review



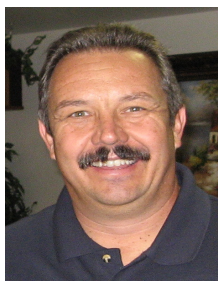

Monrovia's Gang Intervention



JIM HUNT gave us an update on the gang injunction three pronged-prevention, intervention and suppression program. There is a safe zone in Monrovia and the unincorporated areas of Monrovia and Duarte. The safe zone is Foothill Blvd on the north, Mountain, on the east, south to Live Oak, north on Peck Road to Duarte Road, west to Mayflower and north on Mayflower to Foothill Blvd In the safe zone the injunction prohibits association with other gang members, no intimidation of other individuals, stay away from weapons, no drugs, no alcohol, do not vandalize or possess graffiti materials, do not trespass, do not block access and obey the curfew.

The board has earmarked a \$250 check for the Girl Power organization.

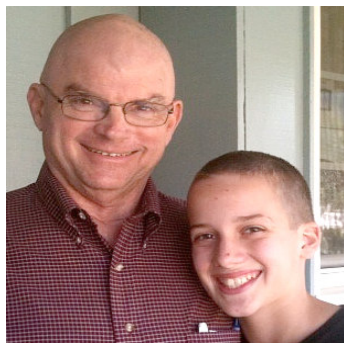
Did you know...
